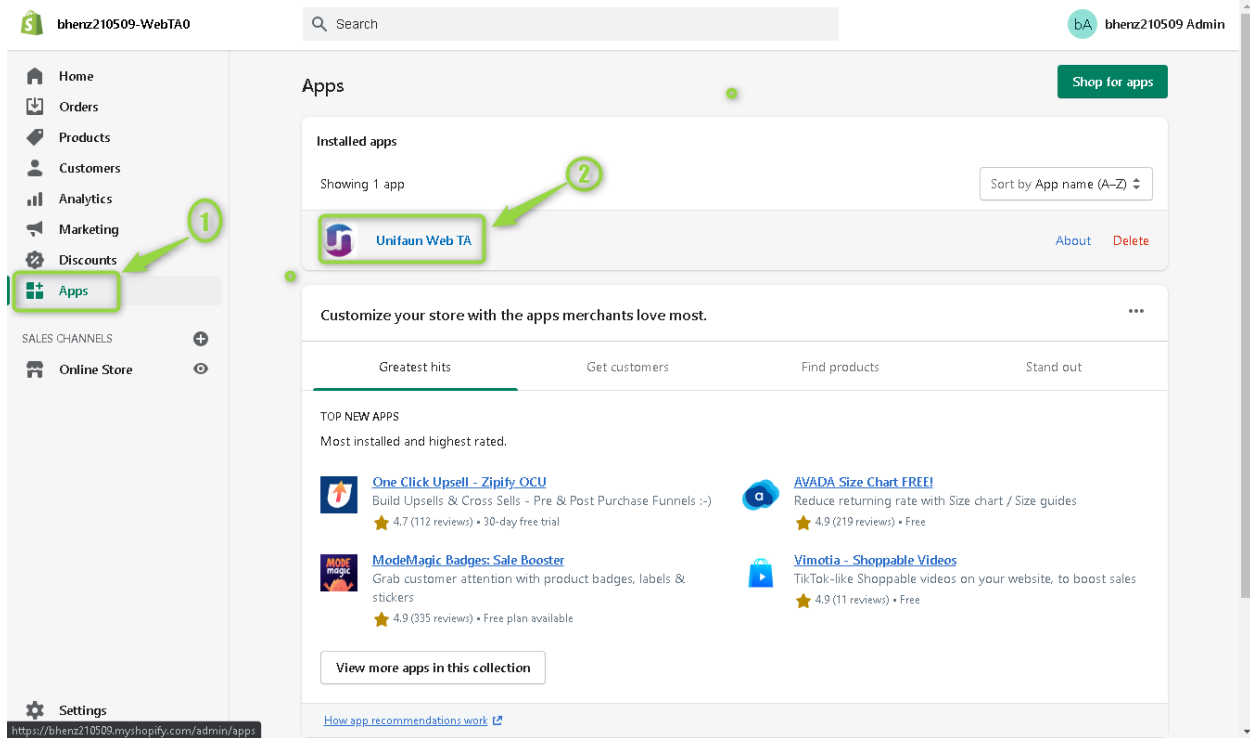

## Step 1

From your Shopify Store URL and click "Apps" then click "Unifaun Web TA".

Your Shopify store URL will be in the format [your-shop-name].myshopify.com.



## Step 2

**Account Settings** – This detail will be provided by the Unifaun Web-TA support Team.
